ACS Extension Program

Non-refundable registration fee (per student): \$75— includes processing and assessment fees

Applying to the Extension Program:

To apply to ACS's Extension Program, please call one of the school offices for a registration packet. The packet includes general information and policies, registration and course selection forms and payment and tuition forms.

-The deadline for the school year is August 19th, 2011.

-After applying and turning in paperwork, you will be contacted by the program director.

Payment Policies:

ACS uses an automatic payment program called CheckFree. A CheckFree tuition contract can be found in the registration packet, outlining all the financial policies for the Extension Program. Families may choose to pay tuition in-full, annually, or they may elect to use CheckFree and have monthly payments deducted from a checking or savings account. Payments are collected on the 5th or 20th of the month. All registration and enhancement class fees are due before the start of the school year.

Why the Extension Program?

If you are a homeschooling family, you have the ease of having your children enrolled in Achiever at a low cost—relieving you from having to log and report learning hours (as long as child is enrolled full-time). Alternatively, if you cannot afford the tuition costs of private school but desire your child to have a Christian education, you can take advantage of the low costs of our program.
